Special Conditions For Competition 7 Air Pistol Mixed Team Finals

- Teams must be nominated, and entry fees paid, at the meeting reception before the first member of the team shoots in the qualifying stage.
- Each team shall comprise a male and a female competitor and, if desired, a nominated coach.
- As the Senior and Junior finals will be run concurrently, no competitor shall enter in both age categories.
- The match will only be held if there are at least 3 teams entered in one of the age categories.
- Qualification for the final shall be from the addition of the first 40 shots in competitions 1 & 4, with those 40 shots being completed in approximately 50 minutes and the 60 shot match being completed in 75 minutes.
- The entry fee shall be £15.00 per team.

Event Rules

The meeting shall otherwise be run generally in accordance with the 2017 ISSF Rules where applicable but please note the following:-

- Ties, other than for positions 1 to 8 in competitions 1, 4, 7, 9 & 12 shall be decided using ISSF countback rules.
- Each competition may only be entered once.
- Competitions 1, 2, 3, 9, 10 & 11 are confined to Men only.**
- Competitions 4, 5, 6, 12, 13 & 14 are confined to Women only.**
- Competition 2 may only be shot after competition 1 (if entered).
Competition 10 may only be shot after competition 9 (if entered).
Competition 5 may only be shot after competition 4 (if entered).
Competition 13 may only be shot after competition 12 (if entered).
- Only those competitors able to comply with the basic ISSF pistol shooting position will be eligible for finals and prize lists.
- Other rules regarding events and prize eligibility to be as previously published by the BPC (available on request).
- No photography will be allowed on any range unless prior permission has been obtained from the BPC. Photography WILL be allowed at prize-givings.
